Nestlé Waters North America To Host Community Forum On Proposed McCloud Bottling Facility

McCloud, CA – The second in a series of community forums regarding Nestlé Waters North America’s revised project proposal in McCloud will be held on February 18, 2009 at the McCloud Elementary School located at 332 Hamilton Way. The meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m.

“We value the input we have received from the McCloud community on our project over the years and that feedback has been used to develop our revised project proposal,” said Dave Palais, Nestlé Waters Natural Resource Manager and McCloud Project Manager. “We look forward to this opportunity to present the main elements of our revised project proposal and to hearing feedback on it from the McCloud community.”

In addition to Palais, Nestlé Waters will be represented by National Director of Natural Resources Brendan O’Rourke. The forum is open to the public and all members of the McCloud Community are welcome and encouraged to attend.

The evening will begin with a brief presentation on the components of the company’s revised project proposal and will provide community members the opportunity to give direct feedback on the proposed project.

This is the second in a series of public forums on Nestlé Waters’ proposed project in McCloud. The purpose of these meetings is to provide the company with direct feedback from the community on the revised project proposal.

The community’s feedback, in conjunction with the additional scientific studies that will be conducted on the revised project, will be used to shape the project proposal and develop a draft environmental impact report for public review and comment.
